Intermanual Couplers: Sw/Gt 16-8-4; Ch/Gt 16-8-4; Sw/Ch 16-8-4; Gt, Sw, Ch/P 8-4
SSL Memory 8 Levels: 8 General Pistons (thumb & toe); 6 Divisional pistons on each of Gt, Sw, Ch (thumb only), P (thumb and toe)
Reversibles: Gt/P, Sw/P, Ch/P, Sw/Gt, Ch/Gt, Sw/Ch, Full organ (all thumb and toe); Contra Posaune (thumb only)
